RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE STATE COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP GRANT FOR THE SALEM INTER-AGENCY COUNCIL 2022 YOUTH SERVICES COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Justice Commission (JJC) has allocated the following funding to the County of Salem Youth Services Commission:

WHEREAS, the Salem County Youth Services Commission has recommended allocation of these funds based on a renewal of the prior year’s plan and monitoring results; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners agrees with these recommendations and authorizes Salem County Inter-Agency Council to enter into agreements for the following services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the County of Salem allocate the JJC Partnership and Family Court funding as follows:
