WHEREAS, the County of Salem was awarded a Local Efficiency Achievement Program (LEAP) grant to support the Feasibility Study for the Unification of Salem County School Districts and Alternatives; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders adopted Resolution 2019-481 on December 30, 2019 to Establish a Fair and Open Process for the Awarding of a Professional Service Contract for Unification of Salem County School District Restructuring Feasibility Study; and
