RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A RENEWAL CONTRACT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SALEM AND SODAT OF NEW JERSEY FOR PROVIDING JUVENILE PROBATION-ENRICHMENT PROGRAMMING WITH TRANSPORTATION FOR 2022

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") recognizes a continuing need to assist the Salem County Youth Services Commission ("SCYSC") and County Council on Juvenile Justice System Improvement ("CJJSI") in efforts to provide approved Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative ("JDAI") Innovations programming for youth adjudicated delinquent; and

WHEREAS, the SCYSC and CJJSI approved a grant application from the New Jersey Juvenile Justice Commission for the JDAI Grant Program in accordance with the certified assurances, grant conditions, award notice on file with the Clerk of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem applied for, received and accepted a New Jersey Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative Innovation Funding Grant ("Grant") for CY 2022 in the total amount of \$120,000.00 (One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents); and

WHEREAS, on April 29, 2021 the Salem County Purchasing Agent received, opened and evaluated proposals from organizations interested in providing a Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative - Probation Enrichment Transportation Program; and

WHEREAS, SODAT of New Jersey was awarded a one-year contract effective May 5, 2021 until December 31, 2021 with one (1) one-year renewal option available pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

1. The Probation Enrichment Program Summary on file with the Clerk of the Board is approved and accepted.
2. A contract is awarded to SODAT of New Jersey, an approved JDAI funding grantee, in the amount of \$38,087.00 (Thirty-eight thousand, eighty-seven dollars and zero cents) to facilitate the CY 2022 JDAI Probation-Enrichment Program with Transportation.
3. Said contract is for the period effective January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022.
4. The Deputy Director of Operations, the Chief Finance Officer, the Salem County Youth Services Coordinator from the Salem Inter Agency Council of Human Services Inc., as well as any other necessary parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all project grant and contract documents provided by the Juvenile Justice Commission.

5. Three fully executed copies of this resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Inter Agency Council of Human Services forthwith.
