RESOLUTION APPROVING PARTICIPATION BY THE SALEM COUNTY PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE WITH THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY GRANT PROGRAMS ADMINISTERED BY THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES FOR THE CHILD ADVOCACY MDT GRANT

WHEREAS, the Attorney General has been designated by the Governor to implement the grant programs under the New Jersey Department of Children and Families; and

WHEREAS, the State Office of Victim Witness Advocacy has elected to administer a grant for the New Jersey Department of Children and Families (DCF) funding provided through the Child Advocacy Center-Multidisciplinary Team Advisory Road for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners previously granted approval of the application for this grant by Resolution No. 2021-362 dated October 20, 2021, and, thereafter, accepted funding from this grant by Resolution No. 2021-426 dated December 15, 2021; and

WHEREAS, this resolution is required by the funding agency for the expenditure of funds in the amount of \$99,855.01 from this grant for the purchase of:

- (a) Cellebrite Advanced Services modules per Quote No. Q-214379-1 dated November 1, 2021, from Cellebrite, Inc. (Vendor No. 03300) in order to provide continued Victim-Witness Advocacy services currently provided for the victims and witnesses of criminal investigations; and
- (b) VAWA/Muskie Report for VW Services modules and training per estimate dated September 22, 2021, from Computer Square, Inc. (Vendor No. 03720) in order to provide continued Victim-Witness Advocacy services currently provided for the victims and witnesses of criminal investigations; and
- (c) VAWA/Muskie Report for a Specialty Module for the Documentation of Child Advocacy Center Activities, including installation and training, per estimate dated September 28, 2021, from Computer Square, Inc. (Vendor No. 03300) in order to provide continued Victim-Witness Advocacy services currently provided for the victims and witnesses of criminal investigations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem approves the above expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem as follows:

1. As a matter of policy, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem wishes to participate to the fullest extent possible with the New Jersey Department of Children and Families (DCF).
2. The Attorney General will receive funds on behalf of all prospective sub-grantees.
3. The Division of Children and Families is authorized to initiate allocations to each sub-grantee.
4. The Board of County Commissioners approves the aforesaid expenditure.
5. Four (4) fully certified copies of this resolution shall be forwarded to the County Prosecutor forthwith.
