RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE NEW JERSEY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY AND THE COUNTY OF SALEM

WHEREAS, the County of Salem ("County") recognizes the importance in developing an infrastructure to support economic growth opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem is creating the Salem County Office of Economic Development to facilitate current and future economic opportunities within the County; and

WHEREAS, the NJ Economic Development Authority ("EDA") recognizes the need to support the implementation of an Economic Development Office in Salem County; and

WHEREAS, the "EDA" has awarded the County of Salem funding from the CARES Act Supplementary Planning Grant monies to explore methods to maximize local economic benefits for the development of long-term strategic infrastructure investments within Salem County; and

WHEREAS, it is desirous of the "EDA" and the "County" to enter into a MOU regarding the provisions of "EDA" support of the implementation of a Salem County Office of Economic Development; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem agrees to undertake the directives outlined in the MOU in exchange for funding in the amount of \$100,000.00 from the "EDA".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that they authorize the Commissioner Director to sign the Memorandum of Understanding between the New Jersey Economic Development Authority and the County of Salem.
