RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING NACCHO MEDICAL RESERVE CORPS COVID-19 RESPOND, INNOVATE, SUSTAIN AND EQUIP (RISE) AWARDS GRANT

WHEREAS, the Salem County Department of Health and Human Services has applied and obtained a grant from The National Association of County & City Health Officials to provide resources to the MRC network to support COVID-19 response efforts, prioritize building capacity for the MRC to respond, innovate to evolving requirements, sustain staffing requirements and equip MRC units and state coordinators with resources needed to support their mission; and

WHEREAS, the total grant funds awarded during the budget period of April 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022, with a possible extension through September 29, 2023 will be in the amount of \$25,000.00 (Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars); and

WHEREAS, no matching funds are required.
