RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO APPLY FOR FUNDING FOR THE 2022-2023 RIGHT TO KNOW GRANT

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners desires to apply for a grant with the New Jersey Department of Health, Division of Epidemiology, Environmental & Occupational Health, to develop and implement a County Right to Know Program; and

WHEREAS, funding for the project will be in the amount of \$8,786.00 and will be paid in quarterly installments of \$2,196.50 made to the County of Salem Health Department for the fiscal year of July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, this agreement shall further be contingent upon availability and appropriation of sufficient funds for this purpose in the County's temporary and/or permanent budget.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem that Commissioner Chair and the Clerk of the Board are hereby authorized to sign the resolution to apply for a grant with the New Jersey Department of Health, Division of Epidemiology, Environmental & Occupational Health for the Right to Know grant.
