RESOLUTION RESCINDING AN AMENDMENT TO THE SALEM COUNTY POLICY AND PROCEDURE MANUAL

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners has been given authority to regulate the internal affairs of the County through NJSA 1:6-10; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders adopted Resolution 2007-586 adopting the Personnel Policies and Procedure Manual as a guide to uniform personnel administration within the County of Salem; and

WHEREAS, the policies have been drafted as a living document that can be reviewed and changed as needed; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 2021-428 amending the Salem County Policy and Procedure Manual; and


WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners is rescinding the policy that regulates Military Leave.
