RESOLUTION AMENDING AND EXTENDING RESOLUTION 2021-059 FOR THE FY21 RURAL 5311/NON-URBANIZED TRANSPORTATION GRANT FUNDING THROUGH NEW JERSEY TRANSIT CORPORATION AND THE SALEM COUNTY OFFICE ON AGING AND DISABILITIES

WHEREAS, the County of Salem adopted Resolution 2021-059 on January 20, 2021, authorizing the Office on Aging and Disabilities to receive funding from New Jersey Transit Corporation for FY21 Rural 5311/Non-Urbanized Transportation Grant for period from January 1, 2021, through December 31, 2021, with a required match provided by Salem Health and Wellness Foundation; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem would like to amend and extend Resolution 2021-059 to use the remaining funds in account G-02-41-731-21D in the amount of \$297,364.50 during the period from January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022 with existing match in account G-02-41-701-15U, G-02-41-701-20U, and G-02-41-701-21U in the amount of \$90,371.50.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1. The Salem County Board of County Commissioners would like to amend and extend Resolution 2021-059 to use the remaining funds of \$297,364.50 in account G-02-41-731-21D for the funding period January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022, with existing match in account G-02-41-701-15U, G-02-41-701-20U, and G-02-41-701-21U in the amount of \$90,371.50.
