RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING THE COVID-19 VACCINATION PROGRAM 2022 ACTIVITY C GRANT

WHEREAS, the Salem County Department of Health and Human Services has applied and obtained a grant from The New Jersey Department of Health to reach Long Term Care Facilities and homebound residents to improve access to COVID-19 vaccine/boosters, expand and diversify opportunities for getting vaccinated, improve and expand messaging/education around vaccination, and strengthen recipient’s coordination on vaccine/booster equity efforts; and

WHEREAS, the total grant funds stated in the application Resolution No. 2022-138 were not to exceed \$200,000.00 (Two Hundred Thousand Dollars), however The New Jersey Department of Health has awarded the amount of \$226,761.00 (Two Hundred Twenty Six Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty One Dollars) for the budget period of April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2023); and

WHEREAS, no matching funds are required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners to hereby accept and execute a grant from The New Jersey Department of Health for The COVID-19 Vaccination Program 2022 Activity C Grant.
