RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AND APPROVING THE SALEM COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE APPLICATION FOR A BODY-WORN CAMERA POLICY AND IMPLEMENTATION PROGRAM APPLICATION FROM THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS (OJP) BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") recognizes a continuing need to assist the Sheriff's Office in the protection of law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Justice Programs (OJP) Bureau of Justice Assistance is offering the Sheriff's Office participation in a Body-Worn Camera Policy and Implementation Program; and

WHEREAS, the application will result in a Grant to the Salem County Sheriff's Office appropriated under FY 2022 Body-Worn Camera Policy and Implementation Program for the period October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2025, in an amount yet to be determined; and

WHEREAS, the Board supports this grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1. The program outlined in the Program Grant Application filed on-line in the grants.gov system is supported and approved by the Public Safety Committee.
