RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SALEM AND THE SALEM COUNTY PROSECUTORS OFFICE ASSISTANT PROSECUTORS ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, authorized representatives of Salem County Prosecutor’s Office Assistant Prosecutor’s Association and the County of Salem over many months have conducted negotiations for a successor collective bargaining agreement ("CBA") for Assistant Prosecutors employed by the County of Salem; and

WHEREAS, negotiations succeeded in producing a Collective Bargaining Agreement and signed by authorized representatives of the parties, subject to ratification by their respective governing body(ies) or membership; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners is desirous of entering into a CBA consistent as to terms and conditions of employment of the contract.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners this 15th day of June 2022, that the Board agrees to the terms of this CBA. The Director is authorized to sign a new CBA for the subject term that shall comport with the Board's intention, after the form of the CBA receives approval by Salem County Counsel.
