RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR A GRANT FROM THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS (OJP) BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP (BVP) PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") recognizes a continuing need to assist in the protection of law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Justice Programs (OJP) Bureau of Justice Assistance is offering Salem County participation in the Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) Program; and

WHEREAS, the application will result in a grant to Salem County appropriated under 2022 Bulletproof Vest Partnership, in an amount yet to be determined; and

WHEREAS, the Board supports this grant application.
