RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AN AGREEMENT AND AUTHORIZING A SUCCESSOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SALEM AND SALEM COUNTY PROSECUTOR DETECTIVE AND INVESTIGATOR’S ASSOCIATION, FOP LODGE NO 6

WHEREAS, authorized representatives of Salem County Detective and Investigator’s Association, FOP Lodge No. 6 and The County of Salem, over many months have conducted negotiations and succeeded in producing a Successor Collective Bargaining Agreement by authorized representatives of the parties; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem and the Salem County Prosecutor Detective and Investigator’s Association previously entered into a Memorandum of Agreement effective January 1, 2021, through December 31, 2021, consistent with the prior agreement as to terms and conditions of employment except as modified by the MOA; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners is desirous of entering into a Successor Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Salem County Prosecutor Detective and Investigator’s Association.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the Board agrees to the terms of the of the Successor Collective Bargaining Agreement retroactive to January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2025, and authorizes the Director and the Director’s agents to sign for the County.
