RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SALEM AND THE SALEM COUNTY VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL SCHOOL FOR A PROBATION ENRICHMENT AND TRANSPORTATION (PET) PROGRAM 2022

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (“Board”) recognizes a continuing need to assist the Salem County Youth Services Commission (“SCYSC”) and County Council on Juvenile Justice System Improvement (“CJJSI”) in efforts to provide approved Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative (“JDAI”) Innovations programming for youth adjudicated delinquent; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem applied for, received, and accepted a New Jersey Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative Innovation Funding Grant (“Grant”) for CY 2022 in the total amount of \$120,000 (One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents); and

WHEREAS, the SCYSC and CJJSI approved a grant application from the New Jersey Juvenile Justice Commission for the 2022 JDAI Grant Program in accordance with the certified assurances, grant conditions, award notice on file with the Clerk of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem issued an invitation for bidders to apply for a grant award of \$45,512.00 (forty five thousand, five hundred and twelve dollars) of the total CY 2022 JDAI Innovations Grant funding of \$120,000 (One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents), to administer the Probation and Transportation Enrichment (PET) Program as proposed within the JDAI Innovations Grant Proposal; and

WHEREAS, the bidding organization awarded the PET program declined to execute the awarded contract with the County of Salem to administer the PET program services and funding total of \$45,512.00 (forty five thousand, five hundred and twelve dollars) for the period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022 which covers the CY 2022 JDAI Innovations Grant contract period; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem re-issued the invitation for new bids on May 5, 2022 and by the proposal deadline of June 1, 2022 received no bids; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey Juvenile Justice Commission approved the execution of a Shared Service Agreement instead of a bid process to expedite the delayed implementation of PET program services and funding needed to benefit Salem County adjudicated delinquent youth for the JDAI Innovations CY 2022 grant contract period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, CCJSI and SCYSC have voted in favor of entering into a Shared Service Agreement with Salem County Vocational Technical School to implement PET program services and funding in the amount of \$45,512.00 (forty five thousand, five hundred and twelve dollars) from the New Jersey JDAI Innovations Funding Program starting immediately upon approval of this resolution through the JDAI Innovations CY 2022 grant contract period end of December 31, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem that:

1. The Shared Services Agreement between the County of Salem and the Salem County Vocational-Technical School for a Probation Enrichment and Transportation (PET) Program is hereby extended, contingent upon continued funding for the program from the New Jersey Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative Innovations Funding Program and satisfactory performance of the SCVT with the PET Program.
2. The term of the Shared Services Agreement on file in the Purchasing Department is hereby extended with the same terms and conditions outlined herein.
3. The PET Program Summary on file with the Clerk of the Board is approved and accepted.
4. The Deputy Director of Operations, the Chief Finance Officer, the Salem County Youth Services Coordinator from the Salem County Inter Agency Council of Human Services Inc., as well as any other necessary parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all project grant documents provided by the Juvenile Justice Commission.
5. Three fully executed copies of this resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Inter Agency Council of Human Services and one fully executed copy shall be provided to the Salem County Vocational Technical School and one fully executed copy shall be provided to the Salem County Purchasing Department to file with the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs.
