**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING A GRANT
FROM THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022
LOCAL FREIGHT IMPACT FUND PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Salem County Engineer's Office made application to the New Jersey Department of Transportation for funds from the LOCAL FREIGHT IMPACT FUND PROGRAM for FISCAL YEAR 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Board previously granted approval of the aforesaid application by Resolution No. 2021-413, dated December 15, 2021 and, therefore, approves acceptance and execution of this Grant; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation has obligated funds for the "FISCAL YEAR 2022 LOCAL FREIGHT IMPACT FUND PROGRAM" in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 for the specific project listed below:

1. Resurfacing and Safety Improvements to Acton Station Road, County Road #653 from NJ Route #49 to NJ Route #45 in Quinton and Mannington Townships; and

WHEREAS, no funding match is required for this Grant; and

WHEREAS, this Grant and Projects are to be referenced as the FISCAL YEAR 2022 LOCAL FREIGHT IMPACT FUND PROGRAM.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

1. The GRANT AGREEMENT, as received from the New Jersey Department of Transportation, be accepted and executed.
2. The Chief Finance Officer and the contact person from the Salem County Engineer's Office, as well as other necessary parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all grant requirements and documentation filings as directed by the New Jersey Department of Transportation.
3. Four (4) fully executed copies of this resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Engineer's Office forthwith.

Dear Commissioner Director Laury:

Enclosed is one copy of the executed Agreement approved by the Department of Transportation for the above referenced project in the amount of \$2,000,000.00.

This project will be funded from the New Jersey Transportation Trust Fund Authority Act. State participation in the cost of the project is limited to 100 percent of the cost of the completed construction work including construction supervision, inspection and material testing, or the amount of the allotment, whichever is less.


Contract deadline: (a) Local Freight Impact Fund agreements shall specify that a contract must be awarded by the municipality or county within 36 months from the date of grant notification. At any time, but at a minimum of 30 days prior to the 36-month deadline, a municipality or county may voluntarily cancel a local freight impact fund agreement and release the funds back to the Department.

Failure to make an award by the contract deadline or to comply with the requirements of the State Aid Regulations and the Terms and Conditions of Grant Agreement for State Aid to Counties and Municipalities will jeopardize the use of State funds on this project. It is further noted that the project must be in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, ADA, requirements for accessibility. The State Aid Regulations and terms and conditions can be found on the Local Aid Website at: www.state.nj.us/transportation/business/localaid/pubs.shtm

Through the approval of this agreement, the sponsor is required to provide submission updates that are to be tracked through the on-line SAGE System. The Sponsor is also responsible for continued updates with respect to the construction administration/management phase of the project in the SAGE System and the Department's new Project Management Reporting System when it comes on-line for local projects. The preparation of contract documents shall use the current Standard Specifications as amended by the current edition of Special Provisions for Local Aid Projects. All requirements of this program can be found in the State Aid Handbook, available at the above website, or at NJDOT Local Aid Resource Center (<https://njdotlocalaidrc.com/>).

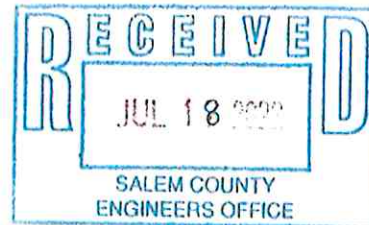
