RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2022-062 AWARDING CONTRACTS FOR PROVIDING DRUG AND ALCOHOL TREATMENT SERVICES FOR THE SALEM COUNTY DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH & ADDICTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Board of Chosen Commissioners of the County of Salem through the Division of Mental Health & Addiction Services has awarded contracts for Drug and Alcohol Treatment Services commencing on January 1, 2022 and terminating on December 31, 2022 by Resolution #2022-62; and

WHEREAS, there was a decrease in Acenda’s need for funding for 2022 and Salem County Division of Mental Health & Addiction Services wishes to amend the Halfway House Services contract by decreasing the originally allocated amount of \$9,000.00 (Nine Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) by \$9,000.00 (Nine Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) for a balance of zero dollars; and

WHEREAS, there was an increase in need for prevention education services for 2022 and the Division of Mental Health & Addiction Services wishes to amend the agreement with the contracted provider, Lori T. Singley, by increasing the original funding amount of \$20,000.00 (Twenty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) by \$9,000.00 (Nine Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) for a total amount of \$29,000.00 (Twenty Nine Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents); and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Treasurer has certified that the funding for this contract in 2022 shall be encumbered in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4 and this agreement shall further be contingent upon the availability and appropriation of sufficient funds for this purpose in the county’s temporary and/or permanent budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Commissioners of the County of Salem approves the contract amendment authorizing Acenda to decrease funds allocated by the County of Salem in the amount of \$9,000.00 (Nine Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) and approves the agreement amendment authorizing Lori T. Singley to increase funds allocated by the County of Salem in the amount of \$9,000.00 (Nine Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) for a total encumbered amount of \$29,000.00 (Twenty Nine Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents).
