**RESOLUTION PROHIBITING NORMAL TRAFFIC
9th ANNUAL COW AND CALF RUN EVENT
KINGS HIGHWAY, COUNTY ROAD #620, HAINES NECK ROAD,
COUNTY ROAD #631 AND BY-PASS ROAD, COUNTY ROAD #540,
IN PILESGROVE TOWNSHIP AND MANNINGTON TOWNSHIP,
IN THE COUNTY OF SALEM**

WHEREAS, requests were received from "Mannington Township" and "Pilesgrove Township" for the partial closure of Kings Highway, County Road #620, Haines Neck Road, County Road #631 and By-Pass Road, County Road #540 on behalf of the "9th, Annual Cow Run 10 Miler and Calf Run 5K Event" sponsored by "Stand Up for Salem, Inc." on Sunday, October 2, 2022 between the hours of 8:00 AM and 1:00 PM; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.1 requires a Municipality to receive consent from the County when normal traffic is prohibited by a parade, procession or assemblage; and

WHEREAS, Kings Highway, County Road #631, Haines Neck Road, County Road #631 and By-Pass Road, County Road #540 are all roads under the jurisdiction of the County of Salem.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the request to prohibit through traffic along the SOUTH BOUND lane ONLY of Kings Highway, County Road #620 between County House Road, a local Pilesgrove Township Road and the intersection with Haines Neck Road, County Road #631 and again from the intersection of Seabrook Road, a local Mannington Township Road to By-Pass Road, County Road #540 and along the WEST BOUND lane ONLY of Haines Neck Road, County Road #631 from Kings Highway, County Road #620 to Halltown Road, a local Mannington Township Road and along the WEST BOUND lane only of By-Pass Road, County Road #540 from Kings Highway, County Road #620 to Pointers-Auburn Road, County Road #540 on Sunday, October 2, 2022 from 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM is approved subject to the following conditions:

1. In keeping with the Governor of the State of New Jersey's COVID 19 directive requiring social distancing and the use of proper PPE, if still in effect.
2. Installation of proper detour signs and notice to the Salem County 911 Central Dispatch of the lane closures.
3. Flag personnel at both ends of each lane closure, to direct traffic.
4. New Jersey State Police personnel at the intersection of Haines Neck Road, County Road #631 and Halltown Road, a local Mannington Township Road and the intersection of By-Pass Road, County Road #540 and Pointers-Auburn Road, County Road #540 to provide safe crossing at the intersections.
5. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to each local governing body.
6. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to each local municipal Office of Emergency Management and Law enforcement with jurisdictional control over the event route for the preparation of an "Event Safety Analysis".

7. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Public Works Department, requesting the County Message Boards be made available at least 24 hours prior to the event if needed based on the "Event Safety Analysis".
8. Copies of this Resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Engineer's Office, the Salem County Office of Emergency Management and the Salem County Sheriff's Department.
