RESOLUTION APPROVING A GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE FY 2022 BODY ARMOR REPLACEMENT PROGRAM (BARP) GRANT FROM THE NEW JERSEY DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE FOR THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") recognizes a continuing need to assist the Prosecutor's Office in the physical protection of law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Criminal Justice is offering the Prosecutor's Office participation in a Body Armor Replacement Program (BARP) for the replacement of body armor in accordance with the Program Grant Application on file with the Clerk of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the application will result in a Grant to the Salem County Prosecutor's Office appropriated under the Division of Criminal Justice FY 2022 Body Armor Replacement Program (BARP) for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2024, in an amount yet to be determined by the Division of Criminal Justice; and

WHEREAS, this agreement shall further be contingent upon availability and appropriation of sufficient funds for this purpose in the County's temporary and/or permanent budget; and

WHEREAS, the Board supports this grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem that:

- 1. The program grant outlined in the Program Grant Application filed on-line in accordance with notification received from the Division of Criminal Justice is supported and approved by the Public Safety Committee.
2. The County Prosecutor, the Chief Finance Officer, the Project Contact person from the Prosecutor's Office, as well as any other necessary parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all project grant documents provided by the Division.
3. Five fully executed copies of this resolution shall be provided to the County Prosecutor forthwith.
