RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ACCEPTING MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT (MAT) GRANT FUNDING FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH AND ADDICTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") recognizes the need to expand the use of Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) to inmates with opioid use disorder (OUD); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the funding is to expand the use of MAT behind the wall for inmates who have OUD, to facilitate a successful reintegration of offenders with OUD into the community upon their release; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) has approved funding for the Salem County Correctional Facility and awarded an annualized contract in the amount of \$200,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the annualized award period is July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1. The Warden, the Sheriff, the Chief Finance Officer, and the Project Contact person from the Correctional Facility, as well as other parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all project grant documents provided by the Division.
2. Three fully executed copies of this resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Correctional Facility forthwith.
