RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING A VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT (VOCA) GRANT FOR THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE FROM THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY, OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATION, GRANT OPERATIONS, [V-17-21]

WHEREAS, the Board previously granted approval of an application to the State of New Jersey, Department of Law and Public Safety for the VOCA Grant Program by Resolution No. 2022-167 on April 6, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Law & Public Safety, Office of Attorney General, Division of Administration, Grant Operations has approved the funding For Victims of Crime Act (VOCA Grant V-17-21) for the Salem County Prosecutor's Office in the amount of \$261,095.00, with a local match of \$129,468.00, totaling \$390,563.00 and;

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the grant award period is for one year from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the project is a joint effort between the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, Office of Attorney General, Division of Administration, Grant Operations, and the Salem County Prosecutor's Office for the purpose described above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem that:

- 1. The grant award on file with the Clerk of the Board is approved and accepted.
2. The County Prosecutor, the Chief Finance Officer, the Project Contact person from the Prosecutor's Office, as well as any other necessary, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all project grant documents provided by the Division.
3. Five fully certified copies of this resolution shall be provided to the County Prosecutor.
