RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING A GRANT FROM THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT, WORKFORCE INNOVATION AND OPPORTUNITY ACT (WIOA) FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2022-2023

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Salem County (the Board) recognizes the need to assist with Adult and Dislocated Workers and Youth; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development approved grant funding for the County of Cumberland; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem is a sub-recipient of grant funding in accordance with the Notice of Award letter on file with the Clerk of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the funding amount is for one (1) year period from July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023, with a total funding of \$665,875.00.

Expenditure Requirements:

- 1 A minimum of 1% (\$6,588) of Adult, DW, and Youth funds must be set aside for professional development to support national conference attendance, locally-driven PD, and the NJDOL/GSETA training partnership.
- 2 A minimum of 75% (\$191,461) of the WIOA Youth program funds must be utilized for service to out-of-school youth.
- 3 A minimum of 20% (\$51,057) of the WIOA Youth program funds must be utilized for work experience services.
- 4 At least 80% of the total funds available by program category must be obligated by June 30, 2023.
- 5 Any unobligated balance that is greater than 20% as of June 30, 2023 shall be subject to deobligation at either or both the grant recipient and State level.
- 6 All funds (100%) must be fully expended by June 30, 2024 or returned to NJDOLWD.
