RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE ENHANCEMENT OF THE SALEM COUNTY OVERDOSE FATALITY REVIEW TEAM

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of Chosen Commissioners recognize the need to continue to facilitate a multi-agency/multi-disciplinary, county-wide Overdose Fatality Review Team (OFRT) to analyze data, identify regional trends and evaluate strategies to decrease opioid deaths and integrate public health infrastructure in the local substance use prevention landscape; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Health has made funding available to aid in this endeavor for the period of October 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, in the amount of \$75,000.00 (Seventy Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents); and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Commissioners of the County of Salem that the Commissioner Chair and the Clerk of the Board are authorizing the application for the funds with the New Jersey Department of Health for the Enhancement of the Salem County Overdose Fatality Review Team Grant.
