RESOLUTION AMENDING 2022 CONTRACTS FOR PROVIDING DRUG AND ALCOHOL TREATMENT SERVICES FOR THE SALEM COUNTY DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH & ADDICTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Board of Chosen Commissioners of the County of Salem through the Division of Mental Health & Addiction Services has awarded contracts for Drug and Alcohol Treatment Services commencing on January 1, 2022 and terminating on December 31, 2022 by Resolution #2022-62; and

WHEREAS, there was a decrease in Acenda's need for funding for 2022 and Salem County Division of Mental Health & Addiction Services wishes to amend the Intensive Outpatient/ Outpatient Services contract by decreasing the originally allocated amount of \$7,000.00 (Seven Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) by \$5,000.00 (Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) for a balance of \$2,000.00 (Two Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents); and

WHEREAS, there was an increase in need for Narcan Kits in our community and the release funds of \$5,000.00 (Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) shall be utilized to purchase these kits for community distribution; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Treasurer has certified that the funding for this contract in 2022 shall be encumbered in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4 and this agreement shall further be contingent upon the availability and appropriation of sufficient funds for this purpose in the county's temporary and/or permanent budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Commissioners of the County of Salem approves the contract amendment authorizing Acenda to decrease funds allocated by the County of Salem in the amount of \$5,000.00 (Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) and approves the released funding to be utilized to purchase Narcan Kits for community distribution.
