RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A MULTI-WAY STOP CONTROL AT THE INTERSECTION OF JERICHO ROAD, COUNTY ROAD #626 AND HARMERSVILLE-PECKS CORNER ROAD, COUNTY ROAD #667 IN QUINTON TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, a safety concern exists at the Intersection of Jericho Road, County Road #626 and Harmersville-Pecks Corner Road, County Road #667 in Quinton Township; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners issued a Contract to "Pennoni, Inc." to evaluate the aforementioned intersection for a formal Traffic Study of the intersection for recommended safety improvements; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has reviewed the formal Traffic Study prepared by "Pennoni, Inc." which supports the establishment of a MULTI-WAY STOP Control at the aforementioned Intersection. A copy of that portion of the Traffic Study associated with this Intersection is attached.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the establishment of a MULTI-WAY STOP CONTROL, at the Intersection of Jericho Road, County Road #626 and Harmersville-Pecks Corner Road, County Road #667 in the Township of Quinton is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a work order be given to the Public Works Department by the County Engineer outlining the changing of the existing intersection to a Four-Way Stop Intersection along with the location and type of signs to be erected and the painting of the appropriate traffic markings to support the establishment of the MULTI-WAY STOP Control; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution and accompanying Traffic Study will be submitted to the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Transportation for informational purposes only.
