RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL FOR FUNDING UNDER THE FY21 AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT "CSFRF" AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE READER (ALPR) INITIATIVE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Office of the Attorney General is to implement funding reimbursement under the Federal Fiscal Year 2021 American Rescue Plan Act, CSFRF, to assist law enforcement agencies in Salem County to invest in new, and expansion of existing, technology and software system integration of ALPRs in the communities they serve; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Office of the Attorney General is offering the Prosecutor's Office participation in an Automated License Plate Reader Program for the purchase of, or enhancing of ALPR units for law enforcement agencies in Salem County, as well as initial software, storage, and maintenance for five (5) years in accordance with the Program Grant Application on file with the Clerk of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the application will result in a Grant to the Salem County Prosecutor's Office appropriated under the New Jersey Office of the Attorney General FY21 American Rescue Plan Act, CSFRF, Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) Program for the period of December 1, 2022 to November 30, 2024, in an amount yet to be determined by the New Jersey Office of the Attorney General; and

WHEREAS, this agreement shall further be contingent upon availability and appropriation of sufficient funds for this purpose in the County's temporary and/or permanent budget; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners supports this grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem as follows:

- The program grant outlined in the Program Grant Application on file with the Clerk of the Board in accordance with notification received from the New Jersey Office of the Attorney General is supported and approved by the Public Safety Committee.
- The County Prosecutor, the Chief Finance Officer, the Project Contact person from the Prosecutor's Office, as well as any other necessary parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all project grant documents provided by the New Jersey Office of the Attorney General.
