RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING A GRANT FOR THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE FROM THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS (OJP) BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP (BVP) PROGRAM [BVP21]

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners ("Board") recognizes a continuing need to assist the Prosecutor's Office and the Office of Justice Program Bureau of Justice Assistance Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program (BVPP) in the purchase of bulletproof vests for the Prosecutor's Office; and

WHEREAS, the BVPP has approved a grant application from the Salem County Prosecutor's Office for the Office of Justice Programs Bureau of Justice Assistance Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program in accordance with the grant acceptance letter on file with the Clerk of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the grant period is from April 1, 2022 to August 31, 2024 with a total funding of \$1,986.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1. The project on file with the Clerk of the Board if approved and accepted.
