RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING THE LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH OVERDOSE FATALITY REVIEW TEAMS 2023 GRANT

WHEREAS, the Salem County Department of Health and Human Services has applied and obtained a grant from the New Jersey Department of Health, Office of Local Public Health to enhance the operations of the Salem County Overdose Fatality Review Team; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds awarded during the budget period of October 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 will persist for a total of three quarters; and

WHEREAS, the total grant funds for the aforementioned budget period will not exceed \$75,000.00 (Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that hereby accept and execute a grant from the New Jersey Department of Health, Office of Local Public Health for the Local Public Health Overdose Fatality Review Teams 2023 Grant, for the period October 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 with the award amount \$75,000.00 (Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents).
