RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT ADDITIONAL FUNDING FROM THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES DIVISION OF AGING SERVICES, FOR THE 2022 AREA PLAN GRANT

WHEREAS, Office on Aging & Disabilities has received additional allocations made by the Department of Health and Human Services under the Older American Act, Area Plan Grant; and

WHEREAS, Office on Aging & Disabilities had accepted Area Plan Grant on Resolution 2021-358 in the amount of \$860,640.00 and now has received additional funding under the American Rescue Plan funds in the amount of \$198,674.00, Expanding Public Workforce funds in the amount of \$78,610.00 and additional Mid-Year federal funds in the amount of \$16,020.00 for a total of \$293,304.00 with no required match.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem that:

- 1. The Salem County Board of County Commissioners accepts the additional funding of \$293,304.00.
