RESOLUTION AMENDING 2022 CONTRACTS FOR PROVIDING DRUG AND ALCOHOL TREATMENT SERVICES FOR THE SALEM COUNTY DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH & ADDICTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem through the Division of Mental Health & Addiction Services has awarded contracts for Drug and Alcohol Treatment Services commencing on January 1, 2022 and terminating on December 31, 2022 by Resolution #2022-62; and

WHEREAS, there was a decrease in Hendricks House Group need for funding for 2022 and Salem County Division of Mental Health & Addiction Services wishes to amend the Halfway House Services contract by decreasing the originally allocated amount of \$15,000.00 (Fifteen Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) by \$5,000.00 (Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) for a balance of \$10,000.00 (Ten Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents); and

WHEREAS, there was an increase in need for Sober Living/ Recovery House services for 2022 and the Division of Mental Health & Addiction Services wishes to amend the agreement with the contracted provider, Maryville, Inc., by increasing the original funding amount of \$20,000.00 (Twenty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) by \$5,000.00 (Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) for a total amount of \$25,000.00 (Twenty Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem approves:

- 1. The contract amendment authorizing Hendricks House Group to decrease funds allocated by the County of Salem in the amount of \$5,000.00 (Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) for a balance of \$10,000.00 (Ten Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents); and
2. Approves the agreement amendment authorizing Maryville, Inc. to increase funds allocated by the County of Salem in the amount of \$5,000.00 (Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) for a total encumbered amount of \$25,000.00 (Twenty Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents).
