RESOLUTION ACCEPTING STATE OF NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS (NJDOC) FUNDING FOR THE DETECTION AND MITIGATION OF COVID-19 IN CONFINEMENT FACILITIES GRANT

WHEREAS, the Salem Board of County Commissioners acknowledges that The New Jersey Department of Corrections is responsible for the operation and management of confinement facilities within the state and there is an ongoing need to combat and respond to COVID-19 infections within confinement facilities; and

WHEREAS, NJDOC has been given funding through NJDOH, and has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with the NJDOH to allocate through the use of sub-grants a portion of funding to the New Jersey County Jails; and

WHEREAS, Salem County Correctional Facility has committed to this project and submitted a Workplan for issuance and receipt of allocated funding; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Corrections (NJDOC) has approved funding for the Salem County Correctional Facility and awarded \$219,274.00 for the grant period of August 1, 2021, through July 31, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1. The County of Salem accept and execute a grant from the New Jersey Department of Corrections for the Detection and Mitigation of COVID-19 in Confinement Facilities.
