RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS (NJDOC) MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR THE DETECTION AND MITIGATION OF COVID-19 IN CONFINEMENT FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners acknowledges the Memorandum of Agreement from the State of New Jersey Department of Corrections for the Detection & Mitigation of COVID-19 In Confinement Facilities Grant; and

WHEREAS, NJDOC has been given funding through NJDOH, and has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with the NJDOH to allocate through the use of Sub-grants a portion of funding to the New Jersey County Jails; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Correctional Facility has committed to this project and submitted a workplan which has been approved on a State level through NJDOC and by the New Jersey Department of Health (NJDOH) and on a Federal level by the CDC; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Correctional Facility has been approved for funding and awarded \$219,274.00 for the grant period of August 1, 2021, through July 31, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1. The acceptance and use of the Memorandum of Agreement is approved.
2. The Warden of the Salem County Correctional Facility is hereby authorized to certify, approve, and sign the Memorandum of Agreement.
