RESOLUTION REQUESTING A TIME EXTENSION FOR STATE AID TO COUNTIES UNDER THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION LOCAL FREIGHT IMPACT FUND PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020

WHEREAS, the NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION made available \$700,000.00 for construction and/or reconstruction of LOCAL FREIGHT INFRASTRUCTURE under the NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION LOCAL FREIGHT IMPACT FUND for FISCAL YEAR 2020; and

WHEREAS, the County submitted the appropriate APPLICATION and GRANT AGREEMENT for FISCAL YEAR 2020 for the RESURFACING AND IMPROVEMENTS TO PORCUPINE ROAD, COUNTY ROAD #643; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer reported that due to delays associated with COVID-19 the project as described above is still in DESIGN and will not meet the MARCH 31, 2023 program deadline for award of a construction contract; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer and Administrator would like to request a six (6) month extension of the Grant Period, making the new deadline for award of a construction contract September 31, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that a formal request be made to the New Jersey Department of Transportation to approve an extension to the FISCAL YEAR 2020 LOCAL FREIGHT IMPACT FUND until September 31, 2023.
