RESOLUTION REQUESTING A SECOND EXTENSION OF TIME FOR THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FISCAL YEAR 2019 LOCAL FREIGHT IMPACT FUND GRANT

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution# 2019-346 on September 18, 2019 approving funding for a reimbursement Grant for the "RESURFACING OF STRAUGHNS MILL ROAD, COUNTY ROAD# 643 AND IMPROVEMENTS TO STRAUGHNS MILL BRIDGE, COUNTY BRIDGE# 1701-141 UNDER THE 2019 LOCAL FREIGHT IMPACT FUND PROGRAM; and

WHEREAS, the original Grant period commenced on July 18, 2019 and ended on July 18, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution# 2022-089 "RESOLUTION REQUESTING AN EXTENSION OF TIME FOR THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FISCAL YEAR 2019 LOCAL FREIGHT IMPACT FUND GRANT extending the Grant time until January 27, 2023; and

WHEREAS, due to foregoing circumstances, the County Engineer would like to request and additional six (6) month extension of the Grant period, making the new deadline for award of a construction contract July 27, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that a formal request be made to the New Jersey Department of Transportation to approve an extension to the FISCAL YEAR 2019 LOCAL FREIGHT AND IMPACT FUND GRANT.
