RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2022-158, ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING NACCHO MEDICAL RESERVE CORPS COVID-19 RESPOND, INNOVATE, SUSTAIN AND EQUIP (RISE) AWARDS GRANT

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners adopted resolution 2022-158 on April 6, 2022, which Authorized the Acceptance and Executing of NACCHO Medical Reserve Corps Covid-19 Respond, Innovate, Sustain and Equip (Rise) Awards Grant; and


WHEREAS, said Salem County Department of Health was awarded funding in the amount of \$25,000.00 (Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars) from the National Association of County & City Health Officials beginning April 1, 2022, thru December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, The National Association of County & City Health Officials has extended the grant period from December 31, 2022, to June 30, 2023, with no additional funds added; and
