RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A SUB-GRANT APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL FOR FUNDING UNDER THE FFY 2018 ADDRESSING THE TRAINING NEEDS OF JUVENILE PROSECUTORS GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Office of the Attorney General is to implement funding reimbursement under the FFY 2018 Addressing the Training Needs of Juvenile Prosecutors Grant Program. The Salem County Prosecutor's Office is committed to having well trained and educated juvenile prosecutors. Juvenile Prosecution is a unique and different area of law. It involves not only the understanding of the Rules of Evidence and trial techniques, but also the appreciation of Adolescent brain development, Trauma-informed Care and Diversion. The role of the juvenile prosecutor is also evolving. As such, the Salem County Prosecutor's Office is committed to improving the knowledge base of all assistant prosecutors assigned to handle Juvenile matters. This sub-grant will be used for those purposes: To train all juvenile assistant prosecutors through supporting their attendance at the 2023 National Conference on Juvenile Justice to learn practices and techniques proven successful in the administration of juvenile justice; and

WHEREAS, the application will result in a sub-grant to the Salem County Prosecutor's Office appropriated under the New Jersey Office of the Attorney General FFY 2018 Addressing the Training Needs of Juvenile Prosecutors Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the grant is set to expire on September 30, 2023, with total funding of \$6,556.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

1. The program grant outlined in the Program Grant Application on file with the Clerk of the Board in accordance with notification received from the New Jersey Office of the Attorney General is supported and approved by the Public Safety Committee; and
2. The Count Prosecutor, the Chief Finance Officer, the Project Contact person from the Prosecutor's Office, as well as any other necessary parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all project grant documents provided by the New Jersey Office of the Attorney General; and
3. Four fully executed copies of this resolution shall be provided to the County Prosecutor forthwith.
