RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BRIDGE #1700-200, LOCATED ON COUNTY ROAD #540 IN THE TOWNSHIP OF CARNEYS POINT, COUNTY OF SALEM, BE KNOWN AS THE "KEVIN HARDIN" BRIDGE

WHEREAS, Kevin Hardin, US Army, Delta Company, 3rd Battalion, 8th Cavalry Combat Medic Veteran served two tours of duty in Iraq and was awarded the Purple Heart; and

WHEREAS, while on patrol with his unit in 2007, an anti-tank missile hit his Humvee; and

WHEREAS, Kevin's injuries resulted in 32 surgeries and a two year stay at Walter Reed Hospital; and

WHEREAS, inoperable shrapnel in his head caused him to have a seizure, passing away at the age of 25; and

WHEREAS, Assemblywoman Beth Sawyer has partnered with the nonprofit organization "Bridges for the Fallen" who honor fallen heroes and their families through bridge dedications; and

WHEREAS, Kevin's family are Carney's Point residents; and

WHEREAS, the bridge selected for dedication is located on County Road #540, Hawks Bridge Road, and is known as Bridge #1700-200.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the above named bridge now be known as the "Kevin Hardin" Bridge.
