**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE  
NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION  
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 LOCAL BRIDGE FUND PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Salem County Engineer's Office made application to the New Jersey Department of Transportation for funds from the "TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND"; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board previously granted approval of the aforesaid application by Resolution No. 2021-399, dated December 1, 2021 and, therefore, approved formal acceptance of this Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Transportation has obligated funds for the "2022 LOCAL BRIDGE FUND PROGRAM" in the amount of \$1,257,656.00 for the REHABILITATION OF SCOUR CRITICAL BRIDGES THROUGHOUT THE COUNTY OF SALEM. Those Bridges included in this Grant are:

1. Telegraph Road Bridge, County Bridge #1701-028 located on Telegraph Road, County Road #540 in Alloway Township;
2. Deep Run Bridge, County Bridge #1701-030 located on Quinton-Alloway Road, County Road #581 in Alloway Township;
3. Pleasant Hill Bridge, County Bridge #1701-088 located on Pleasant Hill Road, a local road, in Alloway Township;
4. Efts Bridge, County Bridge #1701-097 located on Woodstown Road, County Road #603 in Alloway Township;
5. Creek Bridge, County Bridge #1701-161 located on Commissioner's Pike, County Road #581 in Upper Pittsgrove Township;
6. Fiddle Bridge, County Bridge #1701-198 located on Pine Tavern Road, County Road #648 in Upper Pittsgrove Township; and

**WHEREAS**, no funding match is required for this Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, this Grant and Projects are to be referenced as the 2022 LOCAL BRIDGE FUND PROGRAM.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

1. The GRANT AGREEMENT, as received from the New Jersey Department of Transportation, be accepted.
2. The Chief Finance Officer and the contact person from the Salem County Engineer's Office, as well as other necessary parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all Grant requirements and documentation filings as directed by the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

3. Two (2) fully executed copies of this resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Engineer's Office forthwith.
