**RESOLUTION OF THE SALEM COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
APPROVING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION BY THE PROSECUTOR'S  
OFFICE FOR STATE OF NEW JERSEY GRANT PROGRAMS ADMINISTERED BY THE  
DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATION  
PURSUANT TO THE STOP VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN ACT (VAWA)  
[VAWA-47-22]**

**WHEREAS**, the Attorney General has been designated by the Governor to implement the grant programs pursuant to the STOP Violence Against Women Act (VAWA); and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Law and Public Safety, Office of Attorney General, Division of Administration, Grant Operations has elected to administer a grant for the STOP Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) for the period of July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the aforesaid grant provides for the continuation of sexual assault, domestic violence, human trafficking, dating violence and stalking services currently provided for the victims of criminal investigations, through the evaluation and treatment to criminal case disposition; and

**WHEREAS**, the Salem County Board of Commissioners has reviewed the accompanying application and wishes to approve said application; and


**WHEREAS**, the project is a joint effort between the Department of Law and Public Safety and the Salem County Prosecutor's Office for the purpose described in the application attached hereto; and

**WHEREAS**, the aforesaid grant application seeks funds appropriated under the VAWA Grant for the period of July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, in the amount of \$12,553.00 with an in-kind match of \$135,791.00, totaling \$148,344.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners as follows:

1. As a matter of policy, the Salem County Board of Commissioners wishes to participate to the fullest extent possible with the Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Administration.
2. The Attorney General will receive funds on behalf of all prospective sub-grantees.
3. The Division of Administration shall be responsible for reviewing all applications and making recommendations to the Attorney General for selection of sub-grant award recipients.
4. The Division of Administration is authorized to initiate allocations to each sub-grantee.
5. The Salem County Board of Commissioners approves the aforesaid application.

Four fully certified copies of this resolution shall be forwarded to the County Prosecutor forthwith.
