**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN
AMENDMENT TO THE APPLICATION FOR
STATE AID TO COUNTIES UNDER THE
NEW JERSEY TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015
COUNTY AID IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Salem County Engineer's Office made application to the New Jersey Department of Transportation for funds from the TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND; and

WHEREAS, the Board previously grant approval of the aforesaid application by Resolution No. 2015-183, dated April 1, 2015 and, therefore, approves acceptance and execution of this Grant; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation has obligated funds for the "2015 COUNTY AID PROGRAM" in the amount of \$2,365,000.00 in accordance with the fully executed "Funding Agreement" dated June 11, 2015 for the specific projects listed below:

ROADWAY PRESERVATION PROJECTS:

1. Resurfacing of Dutch Row Road, County Road #611 from U.S. Route #40 (MP 11.63) to the Salem County/Gloucester County Line (MP 13.37) – 1.74 miles in Upper Pittsgrove Township;
2. Resurfacing of Hawks Bridge Road, County Road #540 from U.S. Route #40 (MP 0.92) to Haines Neck Road, County Road #631 (MP 2.00) – 1.08 miles in Carneys Point and Mannington Township;
3. Resurfacing of Kings Highway, County Road #620 from Mannington Creek (MP 1.50) to Mannington Creek (MP 1.6) – 0.1 miles in Mannington Township;
4. Resurfacing of Marlton Road, County Road #636 from Kings Highway, County Road #620 (MP 0.00) to the "Marlton Park Recreation Area" near McCourbrie Street, a local road (MP 1.07) – 1.07 miles in Pilesgrove Township;
5. Resurfacing of North Broad Street, County Road #607 from U.S. Route #130 (MP 0.00) to Main Street, County Road #675 (MP 1.27) – 1.27 miles in the Borough of Penns Grove and Carneys Point Township;
6. Resurfacing of Penns Grove-Pedricktown Road, County Road #642 from U.S. Route #130 (MP 0.00) to Straughns Mill Road, County Road #643 (MP 1.48) – 1.48 miles in Oldmans Township;
7. Resurfacing of Pennsville-Auburn Road, County Road #551 from Georgetown Road, County Road #629 (MP 7.16) to N.J. Route #48 (MP 7.83) – 0.67 miles in Carneys Point Township;
8. Resurfacing of Pennsville-Auburn Road, County Road #551 from north of the intersection with Hollywood Avenue, County Road #618 (MP 6.45) to south of the intersection with Georgetown Road, County Road #629 (MP 6.55) – 0.10 miles in Carneys Point Township;
9. Resurfacing of Perkintown Road, County Road #644 from Pennsville-Pedricktown Road, County Road #601 (MP 1.61) to Straughns Mill Road, County Road #643 (MP 3.00) – 1.39 miles in Oldmans Township; and
10. Resurfacing of Telegraph Road, County Road #647 from N.J. Route #49 (MP 0.16) to Cohansey Road, County Road #540 (MP 1.54) – 1.38 miles in Quinton Township.


WHEREAS, the County, at the recommendation of the County Engineer, would like to Amend the original Application by adding the following projects:

1. Purchase of Right-Of-Way and associated costs at the "5 Points Intersection" which includes the following roads: Upper Neck Road, County Road #690; Porchtown Road, County Road #613; and Lawrence Corner Road, County Road #621 in Pittsgrove Township; and
2. Purchase of Right-Of-Way and associated costs at the "6 Points Intersection" which includes the following roads: Parvins Mill Road, County Road #645; Alvine Road, County Road #655; and Garden Road, County Road #674 in Pittsgrove Township; and

WHEREAS, no funding match is required for this Grant; and

WHEREAS, this Grant and Projects are to be referenced as the 2015 COUNTY AID IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that we approve this Amendment to the Application made to the New Jersey Department of Transportation for funding under the NEW JERSEY TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND AUTHORITY ACT for FISCAL YEAR 2015 for transportation projects as described herein.
