**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF SECOND
AMENDMENT TO THE APPLICATION FOR
STATE AID TO COUNTIES UNDER THE
NEW JERSEY TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017
COUNTY AID IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Salem County Engineer's Office made application to the New Jersey Department of Transportation for funds from the TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND; and

WHEREAS, the Board previously grant approval of the aforesaid application by Resolution No. 2017-156, dated April 19, 2017 and, therefore, approves acceptance and execution of this Grant; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation has obligated funds for the "2017 COUNTY AID PROGRAM" in the amount of \$2,399,200.00 in accordance with the fully executed "Funding Agreement" dated May 16, 2017 for the specific projects listed below:

ROADWAY PRESERVATION PROJECTS:

1. Resurfacing of Quinton-Alloway Road, County Road #581 from N.J. Route #49 to Woodstown-Alloway Road, County Road #603 – 3.65 miles in Quinton Township;
2. Resurfacing of Pennsville-Auburn Road, County Road #551 from N.J. Route #140 to Georgetown Road, County Road #629 – 2.04 miles in Carneys Point Township; and
3. Resurfacing of Mckillip Road, County Road #676 from Welchville-Alloway Road, County Road #540 to Mowers Station Road, a local road – 0.57 miles in Alloway Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board Amended the aforementioned original Application for the 2017 COUNTY AID PROGRAM to add the following Project on September 20, 2017 per Resolution #2017-287 described as follows:

1. Salem County Short Line Railroad Port Area Improvements from Fifth Street, a local road, to West Broadway, N.J. Route #49 in the City of Salem; and


WHEREAS, the County, at the recommendation of the County Engineer, would like to Amend the original Application a second time by adding the following projects:

1. Purchase of Right-Of-Way and associated costs at the "5 Points Intersection" which includes the following roads: Upper Neck Road, County Road #690; Porchtown Road, County Road #613; and Lawrence Corner Road, County Road #621 in Pittsgrove Township; and
2. Purchase of Right-Of-Way and associated costs at the "6 Points Intersection" which includes the following roads: Parvins Mill Road, County Road #645; Alvine Road, County Road #655; and Garden Road, County Road #674 in Pittsgrove Township; and

WHEREAS, no funding match is required for this Grant; and

WHEREAS, this Grant and Projects are to be referenced as the 2017 COUNTY AID IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that we approve this Amendment to the Application made to the New Jersey Department of Transportation for funding under the NEW JERSEY TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND AUTHORITY ACT for FISCAL YEAR 2017 for transportation projects as described herein.
