**RESOLUTION PROHIBITING NORMAL TRAFFIC  
ALONG MAPLE AVENUE, COUNTY ROAD #634,  
NORTH AND SOUTH BROAD STREET, COUNTY ROAD #607,  
AND EAST AND WEST MAIN STREET, COUNTY ROAD #675  
FOR A PENNS GROVE DAY PARADE  
IN THE BOROUGH OF PENNS GROVE, SALEM COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, a request was received from the "Borough of Penns Grove" for a PENNS GROVE DAY PARADE along a portion of three (3) County Roads: Maple Avenue, County Road #634 between the intersection of Shell Road, U.S. Route #130 and South Broad Street, County Road #607; North and South Main Street, County Road #607 between the intersection of Maple Avenue, County Road #634 and East and West Main Street, County Road #675; and East and West Main Street, County Road #675 between the intersection of North and South Broad Street, County Road #607 and Delaware Avenue, County Road #675 on Saturday, June 10, 2023 between the hours of 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.1 requires a Municipality to receive consent from the County when normal traffic is prohibited by a parade, procession or assemblage; and


**WHEREAS**, Maple Avenue, County Road #634, North and South Broad Street, County Road #607 and East and West Main Street, County Road #675 are all roads under the jurisdiction of the County of Salem.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the request to prohibit through traffic for a PARADE along Maple Avenue, County Road #634, North and South Main Street, County Road #607 and East and West Main Street, County Road #675 on Saturday, June 10, 2023 between the hours of 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM is approved subject to the following conditions:

1. Installation of proper detour signs and notice to the Salem County 911 Central Dispatch of the road closures.
2. Flag personnel at both ends of the parade area, and all side streets, to direct traffic.
3. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the local governing body.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Municipal Office of Emergency Management and Law Enforcement with jurisdiction over the location for the preparation of an "Event Safety Analysis".
5. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Public Works Department requesting the County Message Boards be made available at 48 hours prior to the event if needed based on the "Event Safety Analysis".
6. Copies of this Resolution shall also be provided to the Salem County Engineer's Office, the Salem County Office of Emergency Services and the Salem County Sheriff's Department.
