



**RESOLUTION PROHIBITING NORMAL TRAFFIC HAWKS BRIDGE ROAD, COUNTY ROAD #540 IN CARNEYS POINT TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF SALEM
HAWKS BRIDGE MEMORIAL DEDICATION**

WHEREAS, a request was received from the Non-Profit Organization "BRIDGES FOR THE FALLEN" for an assemblage along a portion of Hawks Bridge Road, County Road #540 in Carneys Point Township from Orchard Road, a local road to Haines Neck Road, County Road #631 in the area of Hawks Bridge, County Bridge #1700-200 on Sunday, September 24, 2023 between the hours of 10:00 AM and 1:00 PM; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.1 requires an entity to receive consent from the County when normal traffic is prohibited by a parade, procession or assemblage; and

WHEREAS, Hawks Bridge Road, County Road #540 is a road under the jurisdiction of the County of Salem; and

WHEREAS, the Non-Profit Organization "Bridges for the Fallen" will be placing a memorial plaque on Hawks Bridge, County Bridge #1700-200 to Posthumously Honor KEVIN HARDIN, U.S. Army, Delta Company, 3rd Battalion, 8th Cavalry Combat Medic Veteran who served two (2) tours in Iraq and was Awarded the "Purple Heart".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the request to prohibit through traffic for an ASSEMBLAGE along Hawks Bridge Road, County Road #540, in the area of Hawks Bridge, County Bridge #1700-200 on Sunday, September 24, 2023 from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM is approved subject to the following conditions:

1. Installation of proper detour signs and notice to the Salem County 911 Central Dispatch of the road closure.
2. Flag personnel at both ends of the Assemblage area, and all side streets and access areas to direct traffic.
3. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the local governing bodies of Carneys Point Township and Mannington Township.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Municipal Offices of Emergency Management and Law enforcement with jurisdiction over the location for the preparation of an "Event Safety Analysis".
5. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Public Works Department requesting the Salem County Message Boards be made available at least one (1) week prior to the event, if needed, based on the "Event Safety Analysis".

6. Copies of this Resolution shall also be provided to the Salem County Engineer's Office, the Salem County Office of Emergency Management, the Salem County Sherriff's Department, Salem County Corrections and Salem County Veteran Affairs Office.
