RESOLUTION ELIMINATING THE COUNTY RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT AS A CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT


WHEREAS, on April 6, 1977, the County of Salem adopted resolution 77-103 Requiring County Employees to be Residents of the County of Salem in the State of New Jersey as a Condition of Employment; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem recognizes the need to expand the physical area for qualified applicants and allows current employees a wider variety of housing options.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the County Residency Requirement is no longer a condition of employment for Salem County government employees. All public employees must reside in the State of New Jersey (N.J.S.A. 52:14-7 L. 2011, Chapter 70).
