RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN SALEM COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE/OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND THE COOPER UNIVERSITY HEALTH CARE SECTION OF MILITARY, DIPLOMATIC, AND FIELD SURGICAL AFFAIRS (MILDAF)

WHEREAS, Cooper University Hospital is a Level 1 Trauma Center and the only Level 1 Trauma Center in Southern NJ; and

WHEREAS, Cooper University Health Care Section of Military, Diplomatic, and Field Surgical Affairs (MILDAF) currently trains emergency responders involving multi-faceted life sustainment training in a simulated real-world setting; and

WHEREAS, Salem County Sheriff's Office develops and implements a Comprehensive Emergency Operation Plan and responds to both natural and man-made disasters; and

WHEREAS, Salem County Sheriff's Office desires Severe Situation Point of Injury Training for the local governmental and First Responder Agencies; and

WHEREAS, Cooper University Health Care Section of MILDAF is qualified and willing to provide such training at no cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Salem County Board of County Commissioners approves the Memorandum of Understanding and authorizes the Director of Board of County Commissioners and Clerk of the Board to approve and sign this document.
