RESOLUTION PROHIBITING NORMAL TRAFFIC SOUTH RAILROAD AVENUE, COUNTY ROAD #602 IN OLMMANS TOWNSHIP, SALEM COUNTY FOR THEIR ANNUAL PEDRICKTOWN DAY CELEBRATION

WHEREAS, a request was received from "Oldmans Township" for their ANNUAL PEDRICKTOWN DAY CELEBRATION for an assemblage along a portion of South Railroad Avenue, County Road #602 from the intersection of Mill Street, County Road #642 to Freed Road, a local road, on Saturday, October 14th, 2023 between the hours of 8:30 AM and 5:00 PM; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.1 requires a Municipality to receive consent from the County when normal traffic is prohibited by a parade, procession or assemblage; and

WHEREAS, South Railroad Avenue, County Road #602 is a road under the jurisdiction of the County of Salem; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the request to prohibit through traffic for an ASSEMBLAGE along South Railroad Avenue, County Road #602 from the intersection of Mill Street, County Road #642 to Freed Road, a local road, on Saturday, October 14th, 2023 from 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM is approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Installation of proper detour signs and notice to the Salem County 911 Central Dispatch of the road closure.
2. Flag personnel at both ends of the Assemblage area; all side streets; and all access areas – to direct traffic.
3. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the local governing body.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the municipal Office of Emergency Management and Law Enforcement with jurisdiction over the location for the preparation of an "Event Safety Analysis".
5. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Public Works Department, a request to utilize the County Message Boards must be made at least one (1) week prior to the event, if needed based on the "Event Safety Analysis".
6. A copy of this Resolution shall also be provided to the Salem County Engineer's Office, the Salem County Office of Emergency Management and the Salem County Sheriff's Department.
