RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR STATE AID TO COUNTIES UNDER THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION RAIL FREIGHT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024

WHEREAS, the NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION has made available funds under the NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION RAIL FREIGHT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM for FISCAL YEAR 2024; and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that the project, more particularly described in the GRANT APPLICATION for the FISCAL YEAR 2024 RAIL FREIGHT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, as FY 2024 RAILROAD IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE COUNTY OF SALEM for the specific project listed below:

- 1. FENWICK RAILROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT located in the City of Salem. The project includes but is in limited to: removal of the existing box culvert structure; replacement with a new precast concrete box structure; replacement of new sluice gates at the structure; new track on the structure, as well as approaching and departing the structure; and other associated improvements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salem County Board of County Commissioners, formally approves the Grant Application for the above stated project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Diana Ford, Chief of Administrative Services, Salem County Engineer's Office is hereby authorized to submit the electronic Grant Application through the SAGE System, said Application is identified as RAIL-2024-Salem County-013, to the New Jersey Department of Transportation on behalf of the County of Salem; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Jeff Ridgway, Salem County Administrator is hereby authorized to sign the required "Applicant Submission Certification" form on behalf of the County of Salem; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director and Clerk of the Board are hereby authorized to sign the Grant Agreement on behalf of the County of Salem and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the Terms and Conditions of the Grant Agreement and approves the execution of the Grant Agreement.
