
WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners ("Board") recognizes a continuing need to assist the Prosecutor's Office and the Office of Justice Program Bureau of Justice Assistance Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program (BVPP) in the purchase of bulletproof vests for the Prosecutor's Office; and

WHEREAS, the BVPP has approved a grant application from the Salem County Prosecutor's Office for the Office of Justice Programs Bureau of Justice Assistance Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program in accordance with the grant acceptance letter on file with the Clerk of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the grant period is from April 1, 2023 to August 31, 2025 with a total funding of \$2,364.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

1. The project grant on file with the Clerk of the Board is approved and accepted.
2. The County Prosecutor, the Chief Financial Officer, the Project Contact person from the Prosecutor's Office, as well as any other necessary parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all project grant documents provided by the Division.
3. Four fully executed copies of this resolution shall be provided to the County Prosecutor forthwith.
