RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND AND THE COUNTY OF SALEM FOR A PUBLIC HEALTH WORKFORCE TRAINING NEEDS ASSESSMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem adopted Resolution 2023-296 which authorized the execution of a Shared Services Agreement with the County of Cumberland in order to conduct a Public Health Workforce Training Needs Assessment from August 1, 2023 through February 15, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Department of Health and Human Services received notice from the County of Cumberland that additional time will be required for the Rutgers School of Public Health to complete the Public Health Workforce Training Needs Assessment; and

WHEREAS, the Shared Services Agreement between the County of Cumberland and the County of Salem will be extended until May 21, 2024 with all other terms and conditions from the original Shared Services Agreement remaining unchanged and in effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the Share Services Agreement between the County of Cumberland and the County of Salem for a Public Health Workforce Training Needs Assessment be extended to May 21, 2024.
