RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2023-506 AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND EXECUTION OF THE COUNTY INNOVATION GRANT

WHEREAS, the Salem county Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 2023-506 on December 6, 2023 which Authorized the Acceptance and Executing of a Grant from the NJ Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services to Provide Creative and Sustainable Ideas in Opioid Use Disorder (County Innovation Grant); and

WHEREAS, said plan originally set aside \$24,795.00 (Twenty Four Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Five Dollars and Zero Cents) to respond to the opioid epidemic for a project period of October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the County has received notice that the New Jersey Division of Mental Health & Addiction Services has authorized additional funding of the County Innovation Grant; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$4,959.00 (Four Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Nine Dollars and Zero Cents) has been awarded for the total amount of \$29,754.00 (Twenty Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-Four Dollars and No Cents).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem hereby approves the amendment to the Innovation Grant to encompass additional funding in the total amount of \$29,754.00 (Twenty Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Four Dollars and No Cents).
